The scholarship will be presented to Ms. Dias at the 2008 Travelers Championship Family Day at TPC River Highlands in Cromwell, CT on June 17.

Monica Dias, a resident of Bridgeport, CT and a senior at Bridgeport Central High School (Bridgeport, CT), has been a member of The First Tee at Fairchild Wheeler for over five years. She has been a long-time member of The First Tee Team, RBS Mentoring Program, Travel Team and has attended many local field trips and events. Monica has also attended several national events including the Life Skills Academy in Kansas and the Disney Leadership Forum in Florida. She was named as a semi-finalist for The First Tee/RBS Achiever of the Year award, where she received a \$1,000.00 scholarship award, and was named The First Tee Scholar, one of only 40 or so students around the country to earn such a distinction. When she's not participating in the program herself, Monica can be found at Fairchild Wheeler Golf Course assisting the staff with beginner youth programs and overall administrative help.
